## **Active Travel and Road Safety**

Dhoon School is taking part in Active Travel Week w/c 27th September. The children will take part in a special assembly, workshops and lessons, and will be learning about safe walking, cycling and encouraged to think of alternatives to travelling to school by car. All of the work that the children produce will be displayed across the school to help promote the value and importance of Active Travel.

The school has also been invited to participate in a highways group which includes some of our parents, members of the Maughold and Glen Mona community, Commissioners, MHKs and Dol/Government Officers. At the last meeting, the school agreed that we would be a touch point for parents and community members to report "near misses" or other incidents of fast driving, difficulties in road crossing and poor parking. School is simply logging these incidents so that a data set can be compiled - we have no

jurisdiction in terms of following them up. However, we hope that the data we compile will help future discussions so that better solutions can be found to some of these issues.
