


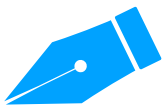
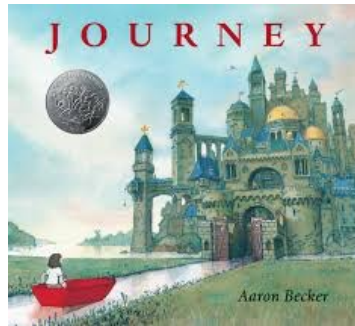
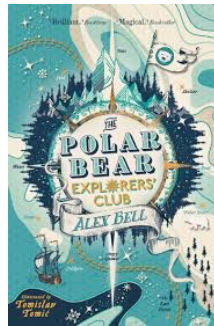
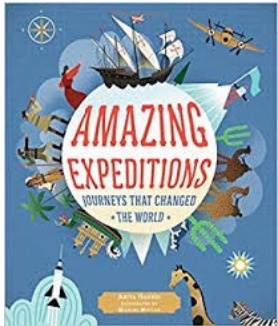


Explorers and Adventurers!

We'll be looking at these books...



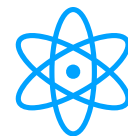
English
