	<p>Easter crafts - there are so many! Can you use empty egg cartons to make Easter rabbits, chicks, hens etc? There are lots of ideas to choose from! Why not try using some leftover wool to make Easter pom pom creatures? Perhaps you could have a go at making an Easter hat/crown/basket/rabbit ears. Explore different designs on a printed egg template: repeated patterns, symmetry etc.</p>	<p>Adverts! Create an advert to promote a brand new Easter egg. This could be a poster, a digital display advert or even an advert for the radio or television. What is so special about this egg and how are you going to encourage people to buy it?</p>	<p>Design Challenge! Design a vehicle that can transport a hard boiled egg safely from one point to another, perhaps even over a homemade bridge! Try designing a device that will protect a hard boiled egg when it is dropped from a height! Design some packaging for a brand new Easter Egg. What will your egg be called? How will your packaging protect it?</p>
	<p>Design an Easter garden using a tray or foil container as a base. Use small stones, mosses, twigs and leaves. Think carefully about colour selection, are your colours complementary or contrasting? Easter Nests Using melted chocolate and either Shredded Wheat or Rice Krispies, create Easter nests and decorate with chicks, eggs etc.</p>	<p>Art and IT Try using your IT skills to create a wonderful Easter card for your family. Can you rotate, duplicate, lock, use the make editable tool and use colour gradients? You can create your own design or choose to be inspired by an Easter picture that you find online. Why not pop your card in the post to Grandparents or friends?</p>	<p>The Easter Games! Try an egg and spoon race in your safe area, adults v children! Have a go at Shot Put eggs (hard boiled), measure each distance in metres and centimetres. (Throw safely!) Easter bunny hops / frog jumps - create your own course and time each person. Design your own scoreboard and medals.</p>
