Dear parents of children due to start Dhoon School in September

RE: Induction for new "Reception" children

Please allow me to officially welcome you and your child to Dhoon School. Preparations are well underway at school to make your child's first year with us a fantastic success and a truly positive first step in their formal education. We can't wait to welcome you and your child to our friendly school and we will do all that we can to make this important time in your life as worry free as possible! We hope that this pack of information answers any questions you have, but please, if you remain unsure about anything then please do get in touch with us. No issue or query is too small!

On Thursday 29th June, your child is invited into school from 9.30am. This will give the incoming Reception cohort an opportunity to experience the school environment, their new classroom and meet their teacher. Parents are invited to come in as well, and once the children are settled, we will be politely asking you to leave! This is the hardest part for any parent, but we absolutely promise you that it is the best thing for the children for you to leave as quickly as possible. It is anticipated that parents can then enjoy a couple of hours of freedom before returning to pick their children up at 11.30am.

On Friday 30th June, your child is invited back into school for a second time, this time arriving at 2pm, and parents can collect them again at the end of the school day (3.20pm) from the front playground. Again, there is no need for parents to stay. This second visit will allow the children to experience a school playtime, and should parents have any questions following the previous day's visit, there is an obvious opportunity to raise these with the school straight away.

We will assume that you and your child are able to attend the induction days as detailed in this letter, unless you contact us to tell us differently. We would urge you to make every effort to attend on these days as it will give your child the opportunity to meet all the other children who will be starting school with them.

I also have great pleasure in enclosing some key information for you in this pack. First and foremost, please find a copy of our Parent Handbook which contains all of the information you need in advance of starting your child at Dhoon. In addition to this, there is a letter from your child's new teacher, Mrs Stewart.

Mrs Stewart will be your child's teacher, and is an extremely qualified and experienced practitioner, especially with the important Reception year group. Mrs Stewart is supported by Miss Cook, our Education Support Officer. Mrs Stewart and Miss Cook work very closely together and are used to teaching this age-group of children. Your child will be in very good hands!

We've also included a "poster" which acts as a guide to helping your child enjoy the exciting journey to becoming school-ready.

I'll finish off with a few practical points which will be of interest:

- We currently have 10 children registered for the class which is a very healthy number for Dhoon School. The children have an extremely spacious area of two classrooms, connected by a shared area. There is also a lovely outside area behind the classrooms, and a log cabin and reading pod area adjacent to them. So plenty of outdoor learning opportunities for your child at Dhoon! The Reception team can split the class into groups for some teaching, which improves the adult:child ratio and enables the numbers to be easily managed – though they are small numbers anyway!
- School uniform can be ordered and purchased from Promenade T-Shirts. We would recommend not purchasing this until towards the end of July or during the August school holiday closures. Children have a habit of growing!
- The school has an active Twitter feed and Facebook page. If you haven't already done so, check them out and keep your eye on them as they give a good flavour of what goes on and act as a window into the life of Dhoon School. We also have a website at http://dhoon.sch.im which has a wealth of additional information.

Finally, we have produced a "virtual welcome" to the school in the form of a video which you can show your child. The video will introduce your child to some key people and let them see their new classroom and begin to familiarise themselves with it. You can find it at:

We are also holding a live Information Briefing for parents via Zoom at 1.30pm on Monday 26th June (the week of the first induction visit) where we will introduce you to the teachers and talk to you about some of the key information you need ready for September. And don't worry, you won't need to remember everything as we'll make a recording of the webinar available on our website, and on your child's first official day in September, we'll hold a brief physical meeting with all of our new parents too - details about that will be shared in the webinar.
