


Origami Easter Bunny




1 Make two creases across the middle of the paper, opening out again each time. Then turn over and do the same corner to corner.



2 Fold the side points toward each other, at the same time bringing the top point down to the bottom of the object to create a diamond shape.




3 Fold the top flap forward, making a crease across the width of the paper.




4 Lift up the object and tuck the bottom flap underneath, again making a crease across the width of the paper. Then put the paper back down and press down on the fold.



5 Lift the flap on the left hand side and fold it to the right, then fold the remaining flap on the left so its parallel with the central crease. Repeat on the right hand side.



6 Flip the rabbit so its right side up. Turn over the rabbits ears so that the inner edges touch the corners above the eyes, making folds that run down the outside of the ears.



7 Lift up your rabbit and open the top of the head. Then poke the rabbits ear back up and unfold it. Make a crease at the back of the rabbits ear at a gentle angle. Press down and then to complete your rabbits ear push up on the bottom fold and make a crease running along the pink part of your bunnies ear. To finish your Easter bunny repeat step seven on the other ear.
