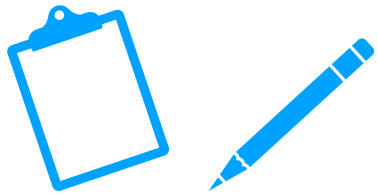

Tuesday 12th January - Follow up challenges/ suggested learning:

- **Literacy** : Revisit the powerpoint, 'Adverbial Phrases and Fronted Adverbials' and attempt/discuss the activities shown (slides 7 - 11).
- Use excerpts from a chosen book (I used, 'The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe') and experiment with changing sentences structure, including moving adverbial phrases. You may even change word order. Do you think you have improved sentences?
- **Science** : **Science Concept Cartoons**
- I have created concept cartoons based on the information in your, '**Properties and Changes of Materials**' **knowledge organiser**. Think about what each child is saying and whether you agree or disagree. It is important to give reasons and evidence them, using information found in the knowledge organiser.
- Remember that I'll be asking you questions about materials in tomorrow's lesson.
