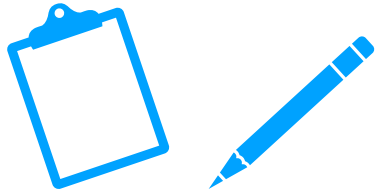


# Friday 22nd January 2021
