



## Class 2 Literacy Grid (2)

### Lesson One - Reading Comprehension

(Non-fiction task)

For this task you will need the **'Palm Oil'** Reading Comprehension sheets.



**Palm Oil** - on the Class 2 website page you will see three sets of **'Palm Oil'** reading comprehension sheets. We would like you to choose your level of challenge from the **'Bronze'**, **'Silver'** or **'Gold'** sheets. Read them through carefully to make sure that you have chosen the right level of challenge for you. We have completed activities like this in class and in our online 'live' lessons so here are some reminders to help you:

- Read through the text at least twice to help you develop your understanding
- Underline any unfamiliar words - can you use a dictionary to help you find out what they mean or perhaps chat about them with a grown up?
- Read each question very carefully to make sure that you understand exactly what it is asking you
- Remember to write you answers in full sentences (maybe using some of the words from the question to help you get started) using capital letters and full stops

### Lesson Two - Prepositions

For this task you will need to choose from the 'Preposition' worksheet activities on our Class 2 website page.

**Prepositions** - in our 'live' lessons we have been focussing on using 'Prepositions'. For today's task, we would like you to choose a task(s) that you think will really challenge you from the selection of 'Prepositions' worksheets on our website page. Some of these sheets will take longer than others to complete, so you might like to do more than one or do a short piece of your own choice writing, underlining any prepositions or prepositional phrases you have used to help you to consolidate your learning.

### Lesson Three - Story writing 'Taking Shelter'

Today you will need the Pobble 365 **'Taking Shelter'** pdf.

We have included some 'rainforest' lined paper for you to use when completing this task.

**'Taking Shelter'** - your task today is going to be to continue the story from this point:

***"He stared into the forest, wondering when his companions might return ...."***

We have put some story planning templates onto the website to help you plan and there are also some prompt questions on the second page of the pdf to help guide your thinking about this task. Be really adventurous in your choice of **powerful verbs** and **amazing adjectives** and try to add some **direct speech** too, if you can. Have fun with this super writing task, we're looking forward to seeing how creative and imaginative you can be!

### Lesson Four - Rainforest Writing

For this activity you will need the **'Rainforest Quick Writing Tasks'** from our website page. We have included a **'rainforest descriptive word mat'** to help you.

### Rainforest Quick Writing Tasks

- we are really thinking about being super writers in Class 2 so we have put together a selection of quick writing tasks that will help us to build on all of the writing skills we have been working on over the past few weeks. There are five different tasks for you to choose from; we would like you to pick one and having a go at working your way through each of the sections. The tasks include thinking about ambitious vocabulary, speech marks, writing good answers to questions and short writing tasks. We hope that you will find one that really appeals to you and enjoy completing it.

### Lesson Five - Rainforest Fact files

For this task we have included a fact file template for you to work from if you would like to and an example of a rainforest fact file - Mrs Shimmin's favourite creature!

### Rainforest Fact files

- for this task we would like you to create a fact file about a rainforest creature that really appeals to you. You will need to use books and maybe the internet to research as much information as you can about your creature; please remember to think carefully about internet safety if you choose to use it to find out about your creature - always do 'safe searches'. When you have completed your research, write about your creature in your own words; you might like to do your writing on the fact file template we have provided or you can create one of your own.
