	Literacy
1	Retell the story of Kippers Birthday in your own words.
2	Write a list of all the people/ toys that you would like to invite to your party.
3	Write a party invitation to send to your friends/toys.
4	Write a shopping list for the party food that you will need.
5	Think of a game that you would like to play at the party and write a set of instructions for it.

	Numeracy
1	Time - Draw a clock face to show the times of the day when you have your meals. Can you show this in analogue, digital and word form?
2	Fraction fun with food - Cut sandwiches, fruit, toast, sausages etc into halves and quarters. Draw a picture of what it looks like and write it down in the form of a fraction.
3	Learn days of the week and months of the year in order. Practise Reading and spelling these too.
4	Look at your list of party food and make a tally chart to show how many people in your family like each types of party food. Can you show this information in a graph?
5	Problem solving - How many people have you invited to your party? If each person has 1 sandwich, 2 sausages and 1 cake, how many pieces of food would you need altogether? Can you create some of your own word problems to solve and then work out the answer?

	Creative Acitivities
1	Make a birthday card for your favourite teddy.
2	Make a present and your own wrapping paper for your favourite teddy.
3	Design bunting for the party.
4	Create your own party food using play dough or junk modelling. Then have a tea party with your toys.
5	Bake a real cake and have a tea party with your family. Remember to follow the recipe carefully!
