**negative numbers.** Problem solving activities will relate it to real life experiences.

Session 3

Converting pounds to pence

We will find out how to record money totals using the **£ sign and decimal points.** we will look at how to convert pounds to pence or pence to pounds.

Session 4

Checking your answers

This session is related to session 1 and we will be looking at how to **use the inverse operation** to help check our answers at the end of a calculation.

Session 5

Roman numerals

We will be looking at **Roman numerals** up to 100 and finding out about the rule they used to devise their number system
