



Hi Class 2, we hope that you're all well. Here are some new learning activities to start off the Summer term. There is a little bit of a hint about a mini theme here, too!

Lesson One - Maths session 1	Finding Tenths on a number line - A tenth is made when you divide a whole into ten parts. Number lines are a really useful resource to use to help us to find where numbers sit in relation to one another. In today's lesson we will explore the different ways in which tenths can be represented.
Lesson Two - Elephants Comprehension For this task you will need to select from the 'Bronze', 'Silver' or 'Gold' challenges on our class page.	Elephants Reading Comprehension - On the Class 2 website page you will find three sets of 'Elephants' reading comprehension activities. There are three levels of challenge to choose from, 'Bronze, 'Silver' and 'Gold', so please select carefully to make sure that you complete the right level of challenge for you. Remember to answer the questions using full sentence answers like we have been practising, please.

We are going to be working on persuasive writing this week so you might like to have a go at these instead. (Adult guidance is included.)
Lesson Three - Maths session 2	Finding Tenths as a decimal - in our lesson today we will be looking at how to write tenths as decimals and how we can use a place value chart to help us with this.
Lesson Four - Design a new chocolate bar! On our class website page, you will find a set of resources to help you with this task: a design a chocolate bar template, a design a wrapper template, blank chocolate border templates and a persuasive letter checklist.	Design a new chocolate bar! - Cadbury invent new chocolate bars all of the time and have done since the very beginning of their chocolate journey - now it's your turn! We would like you to invent a chocolate bar of your own: what will it look like? What ingredients will you use? What shape/size will it be? What will you call your new product? Can you design a wrapper for it as well? We have added some templates to our website page to help you. Literacy task! Write a persuasive letter to Cadbury, convincing them to launch your new product. How will you persuade them - you will need to make your new bar sound absolutely amazing! We will be working on persuasive writing techniques in our live lessons and will add more resources for you to use along the way once we have discovered more about these useful techniques.
Lesson Five - Maths session 3	<u>Co-ordinates</u> - In today's session we will look at how to find simple grid references. We will find and plots different points on 2-D grids as co-ordinates and will use the phrase "along the hall and up the stairs" to help us with this. All will be revealed!

There are multiplication tasks, spelling activities, reading journal tasks and handwriting practise sheets for you to explore, so please try to keep up with some of these important learning skills too.
