Time Connectives

As you write your fact file, work to open and extend sentences (and paragraphs) in different ways. Time connectives will be important as your fact file will be chronological; this will enable you to make links, as well as helping your writing flow.

A *year* later... She left school when...

Years later... Now she was ready to...

In 1983 she was.... This experience would...

During 1983 She had learnt...

At that time... It was one of the most important...

At the age of At the age of 15 she decided to...

By the time *she* was 15,... This was a difficult time for *her* ...

After leaving After 3 years, she would return...

After the events of... In 1983, during the...

She would never forget... Five years passed and...

Following the events of... Five years passed before...

After what happened... In the 1980s...

The next thing she knew.... The events of 1983 would prove...

Then there was the time... Then, on the 6th April 1983...

A friend remembered... Three *months* later *she* became...

She always remembered... The 6th April 1983 would be...

She would never forget... People will never forget...

Her sister recalled how... She will never be forgotten because...

Until 1983... Finally... At last ... In the end

Remember that these connectives can often be used within sentences as you link sentences clauses. Think about using punctuation including, commas (,), semi colons (;) or dashes (-).

Don't forget there are many other connectives you may use.
