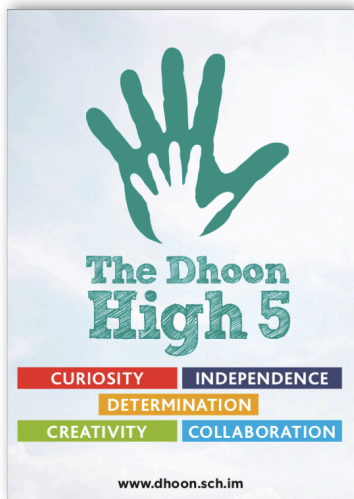


Class 3 – Week 4 Remote Learning Activity Grid

Within this grid you will mostly find literacy or maths activities, which could provide a focus for learning earlier in the day before our live lesson (and follow up tasks) each afternoon. Notice how the activities have continued to mostly focus on **numeracy** and **literacy** (often linking to our themes of equality and democracy). Resources will be posted on the website.

<p>Day 16 (Wednesday 24th March) <u>Measure and Calculate Area</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Watch, discuss and work through the 'Areas of Compound Shapes' slides. - *Attempt the collection of questions, 'Areas of Compound Shapes' (* 3 levels of challenge - Attempt at least 1 page on each. Choose which suits you best.) <p><u>Extra Challenge: 'Area and Perimeter - Reasoning and Problem Solving Challenge'</u> This certainly is a challenge, but I think you'll enjoy trying to work through this.</p>	<p>Day 17 (Thursday 25th March) <u>Trouble of the tangled trainers</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Can you solve this mystery? You will need to apply your literacy skills along the way, including reading, spelling and word building, to help you solve 5 clues. Once you have solved the 5 clues, you'll be able to identify the culprit! Enjoy :-) <p><u>Extra Challenge: 60 Second Reads</u> - Two texts are included today, 'Help' and 'UFO Sighting'. Read the short text, discuss and answer questions.(Parents' Guide included.)</p>	<p>Day 18 (Friday 26th March) <u>The Easter Story and Celebrations</u></p> <p>As Easter and Holy Week approach, these activities will enable you to learn about Easter and related events in Jesus' life.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Read and discuss 'The Story of Easter' and guided reading questions. - Discuss the story and order events using the 'Sequencing' and 'Game Loop' cards. <p><u>Extra Challenges:</u> Use '<u>Class Discussion Cards</u>' to reflect and deepen understanding. Some Easter mindful colouring for you too.</p>
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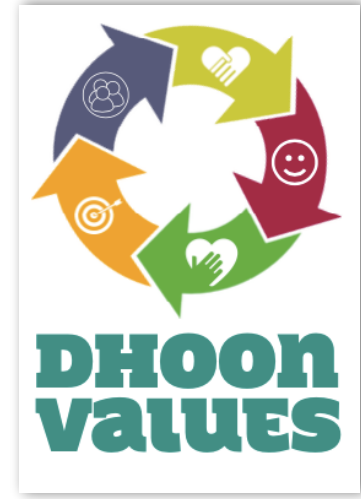


****Day 19 (Monday 12th April)**
Who dunnit?- The Mystery of The Missing Painting

- You are Detective Dunit and there is a mystery for you to solve! Your literacy and creative thinking skills are required.
- Read *'The Mystery of the Missing Painting' text and then record your deductions using the *'Deductions Grid'. (*3 levels, choose level appropriate for you.)
- Extra Challenge: 60 Second Reads - 'Rollercoasters' and 'Whodunnit Poem'.

****Day 20 (Tuesday 13th April)**
3D Shapes and Telling The Time

- Properties of 3D shapes - Sort the 3D shapes so they reach their holiday destinations. Extra challenges too.
- Discuss/practice telling the time using 12 and 24 hour clock. (See slides 2-4. Slide 8 may also be useful for practice).
- 'Time Problem Solving' - Includes the 'Busy Weekend' problems. (Slides 5/6)
- Extra Challenge: 'Hogwarts Timetable' investigation. (see slide 10)



You may find that you do not complete everything on that day and that is fine. You can revisit activities later, as often as you wish.
