## Thursday 15th April 2021 ONLINE LESSON In this lesson we will:



- Today we will be learning about <u>Islam</u> and the <u>festival of Ramadan</u>, which is currently being observed by Muslims across the globe. This is the ninth month in the Islamic calendar, a lunar calendar based on the cycles of the moon, something we discussed earlier this year. Can you remember why?
  - We will learn about traditions and customs, including how and why Muslims <u>fast</u> (4th Pillar of Islam) throughout this month and what happens at the end of Ramadan.
- We'll use artefacts to help us understand ways in which Muslims worship, including how they take part in prayer (2nd Pillar of Islam).
  (If time allows we will play the 'Countdown' word game too. :-)

## Thursday 15th April - Follow up challenges/ suggested learning:

(Remember that these can be attempted and revisited at any time throughout lockdown. :-) To prepare you for Friday's live lesson, here are some ideas:

- View, discuss and work through the 'Classifying Living Things' slideshow. There are questions throughout for you to respond too and an 'exit task' to think about at the end too.
- 'Classifying Living Things activity an opportunity for you to develop and apply your understanding of each group classification of animals and to think of and name species which belong to each group.
- 'Making Classification Keys activity' Formulate questions which enable you to sort/classify different species of living things. Focus on using scientific vocabulary and remember that you may also think about behaviour and habitats too.
- There is even a chance here to imagine that you have **discovered a new living organism** and record details of characteristics and how scientists would classify it.

I have included some sets of **maths assessment questions** you may wish to have a go at:

- 'Place Value assessment 1' and 'Place Value assessment 2', with assessment 2 providing a greater level of challenge.

- 'Data Handling assessment' - Focusing on reading and completing graphs and tables of data. Answers are included for these to enable you to check and to help you work through and understand those questions you may have found more difficult.
